Booking a Flight

It is the planned route and schedule of your trip.



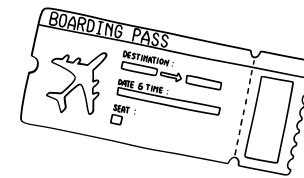
Destination

It refers to the place where you are going.



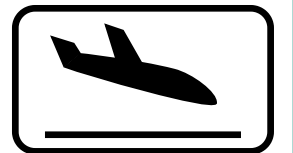
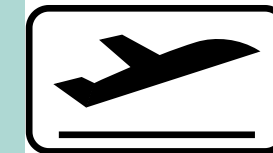
Boarding Pass

A document that allows a passenger to get on an airplane. It is sent after the check-up.



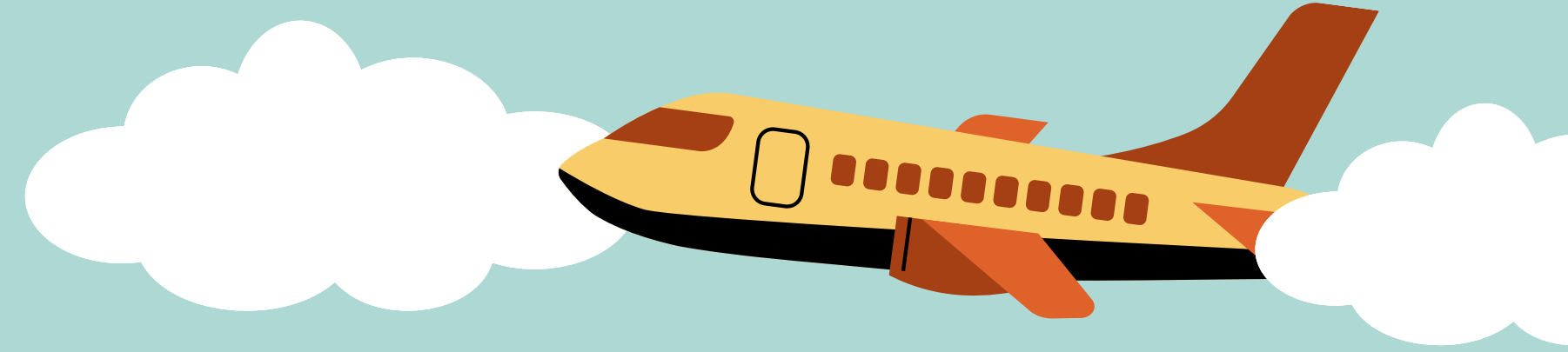
Departure and Arrival

Booking a Flight

These are things that are absolutely necessary to include in your packing list, such as toiletries and clothes.

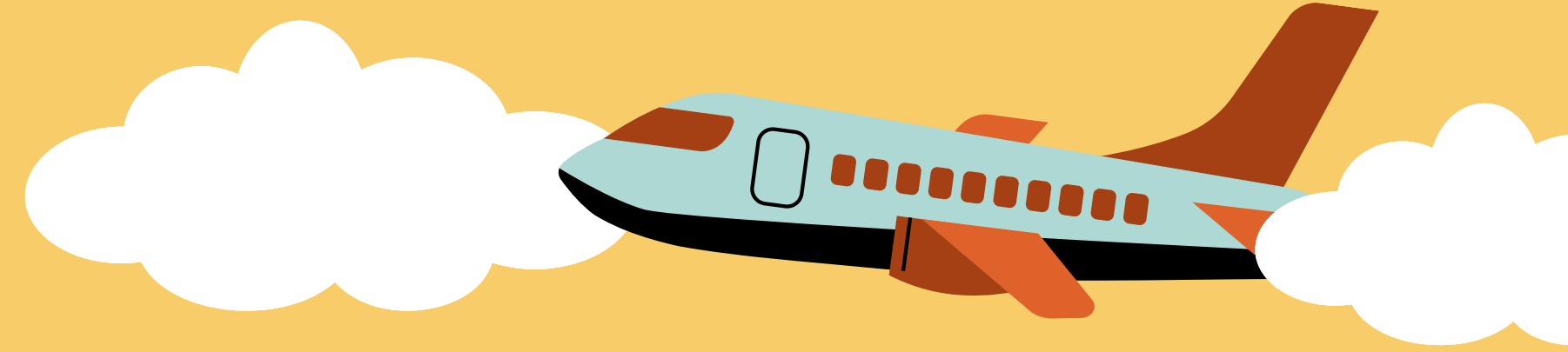


Toiletries

Navigating an Airport



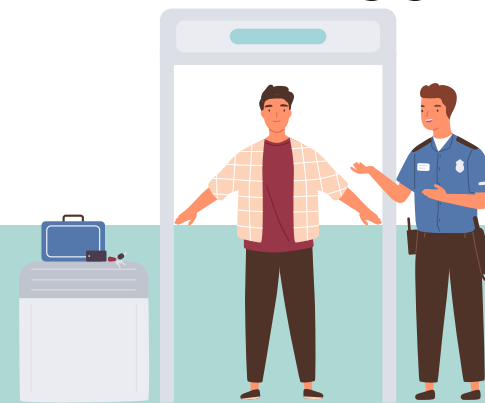
Gate

These are facilities you can find in an airport.



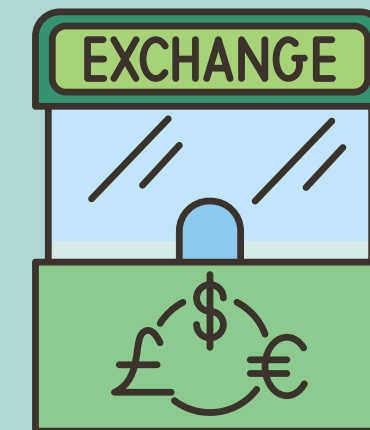

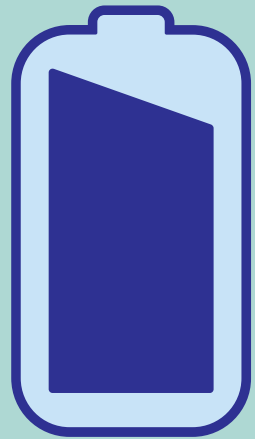
